



Gertrude Street Bridge Deck Joint Replacement Project

December 2019

To address aging infrastructure and improve the long-term structural integrity of the Gertrude Street Bridge deck, a City of Port Alberni contractor, Mainroad Mid-Island Contracting, will be replacing the bridge's deck joint.

THE PROJECT

Starting the week of December 2, 2019, Mainroad Mid-Island Contracting will mobilize on Gertrude Street at Roger Street to begin the deck joint replacement process.

Work procedures will happen across the entire bridge deck. As a result, one lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained at all times. The southbound left turn signal on Gertrude Street heading onto Roger Street will be temporarily decommissioned for the duration of the project to accommodate for the work zone.

Please use caution when in the area, follow posted signage and adhere to directions from traffic control personnel. To avoid delays and reduce traffic congestion around the construction zone, please use an alternate route.

WHAT IS A DECK JOINT?

Concrete is not a forgiving material. It doesn't bend or stretch, but it does expand and shrink as the weather warms and cools, resulting in the structural elements shifting slightly. Such is the case with the current Gertrude Street Bridge deck. To ensure the integrity of the bridge deck is maintained for years to come, the expansion joint between the two sections of the bridge is being replaced.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Replacement of the deck joint will include:

- saw-cutting the concrete the joint
- removing the aging joint in sections
- preparing the impacted surface area
- installing the new deck joint
- sealing the new deck joint
- testing the new deck joint

Following completion, the new joint will be tested and once approved, the area will be restored to similar or better conditions and traffic patterns reinstated.

TRAFFIC & TRANSIT

Traffic pattern changes on Gertrude Street between Roger Street and Pemberton Road will be in effect for the duration of the project. People traveling through the area should anticipate traffic delays.

Transit services will not be impacted as a result of the project; however, bus stops in the area may be temporarily moved to accommodate for the traffic pattern changes.

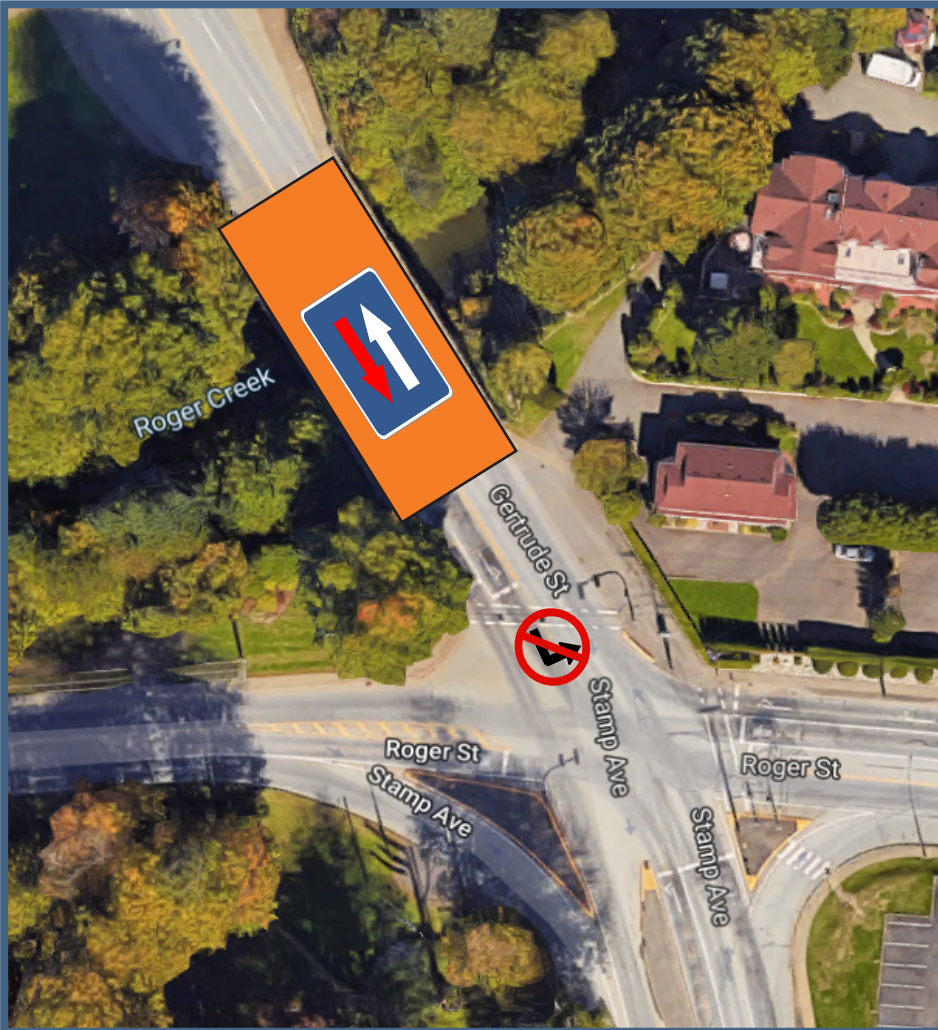
WORK HOURS

Work will generally occur Monday to Friday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. There may be times when crews will need to work longer or on weekends to maintain the schedule.

ACCESS TO YOUR PROPERTY OR BUSINESS

Access will be maintained at all times; however, there could be circumstances when the contractor needs to temporarily block vehicle access to reposition equipment or complete a specific task. To help reduce inconvenience, the contractor will:

- provide advance notice when driveways will be blocked;
- determine alternate options for access and parking, if available;
- keep emergency services informed;
- update residents and stakeholders on project progress; and
- be available to answer questions and address concerns.
