



LIFEGUARD/SWIM INSTRUCTOR

The City of Port Alberni is currently accepting applications from enthusiastic, reliable, responsible and qualified candidates who are interested in working as a Lifeguard/Swim Instructor at our Aquatic Centre. There are casual and part-time positions available with candidates having the opportunity to work up to 40 hours per week. Successful applicants will be able to work a scheduled set of hours (5-30 per week), or work on an on-call basis.

Successful candidates will perform lifeguard and swim instruction duties, and ensure the safety and enjoyment of guests at our swim sessions and lesson programs. This position also responds to emergencies and incidents requiring first aid. Applicants must have completed Grade 10 and be a minimum of 16 years of age, have great customer service skills and be available to work evenings and weekends.

Required qualifications include:

- Current Lifesaving Society National Lifeguard Award (NL Pool Option)
- Current Lifesaving Society Swim for Life Instructor
- Current recognized Standard First Aid with CPR C/AED certification

Qualified applicants will take part in an evaluation session which will include written and practical evaluations of lifeguarding skills and abilities. Candidates will be required to successfully complete a pre-employment fitness evaluation and a Police Information Check. The current rate of pay for these positions is \$33.83 per hour plus 15% in lieu of benefits.
