### **More Child Care Spaces Coming**

A significant investment in the children of Port Alberni will provide a new multi-use Child Care Centre with 88 extra child care spaces for children of all ages – from infants and toddlers to after school students. The new \$2.9 million facility is made possible through the Childcare BC New Spaces fund, with added funding from the Union of B.C. Municipalities.

#### Sidewalk Patios Extended

Responding to the impact of COVID-19, City Council quickly enabled commercial operators to use city-owned sidewalks until June 1, 2022. These Temporary Sidewalk Patio Guidelines and general license to occupy allows them to continue operating, supporting them in the short term, while City staff work on criteria for operators to apply for permanent extensions.

### **Connect the Quays Update**

Public engagement on this unique public path linking Victoria Quay and Harbour Quay has provided extensive input to Council on public concerns ranging from parking and bicycle repair stations to upgrading the dyke as well as individuals expressing support and excitement about the initiative. Next step: design and construct two segments of the pathway in 2022.

### A Whale's Worth of Organics Every Month!

The launch of the roadside organics service last fall was a huge success. After the first month, almost 150 tonnes of organics were diverted from the landfill—the equivalent of a huge blue whale. After just four months, organics curbside pickup exceeded garbage collection, with a total of 667 tonnes. That's a blue whale every month!

### **Supporting Our Most Vulnerable Community**

Last fall, Council approved multiple contracts via RFP delivering on grant funds received through the UBCM Strengthening Communities' Services fund to support unsheltered homeless people and to address related community health and safety challenges. A special Coordination Hub will oversee development of Homeless Outreach Services, Temporary Employment for Unsheltered Homeless, Youth Outreach Services and a Drop-In Centre. This project is a unique opportunity to showcase the important work of valued community partners.
