QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of the City of Port Alberni Council if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day December 14, 2024;
- Resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- Not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2024 By-election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:
